## Kilmarnock Station Railway Heritage Trust- Howard Park update



KSRHT are delighted to be able to continue to progress our proposals for the Howard Park, Old Peoples Cabin. Over the last couple of weeks we have arranged site visits with our Architect to see what additional measures could be included within our bid to take account of the strong feedback that residents did not feel safe in the park some evenings because of the amount of Anti Social Behaviour. Proposals will be drawn up to show what measurers can be put in place to make the park a safer place during the early evenings and we will share in a future update.

Furthermore we also have our consultation active for the Bowling Club building to turn this into an accessible Community Gym to help those recovering from surgery and those with additional support needs.
