I write on behalf of New Farm Loch Community Council in relation to the Common Good Consultation for the lease extension for Dean Thistle.

The Community Council met on Thursday 25th January and discussed the consultation document related to the application for lease of common good land to Dean Thistle, in particular a 25 year extension to their lease of the football pavilion within the Dean Park estate and management of agreed pitches.

Please note below the comments from the Members of the New Farm Loch Community Council.

"It was noted that the Community Council are supportive of the lease extension however, they recognise that parking is currently an issue in that area, and with the club increasing activities, the parking issue and impact to New Farm Loch areas will get worse. Parking issues would be better dealt with sooner rather than later and not just wait for the tenure to be secured."
